40 DAYS

11th August (Elul 1) - 19th September (Yom Kippur)

Traditionally, the Jews celebrate a time of fasting and repentance for “forty days” leading up to The Day of Atonement (Yom Kippur). This period lasts the whole month of Elul, which is the month of “searching and accounting” for our sins, and the first ten days of Tishri, where the Feast of Trumpets is celebrated, prophetically ushering in the Messiah to meet with His Prepared Bride.

The month of Elul is the same time that Moses went to Mount Sinai to prepare the second set of tablets after the incident of the golden calf (Exodus 32; 34:27-28).

The first day of Elul commenced a period of “forty days” where Moses prayed for the Lord to forgive the people after they committed adultery with the golden calf. After this, the commandment to prepare the second set of tablets was given.

As a church, we are following this pattern of fasting and repentance from August 11th (Elul 1) until September 19th (Tishri 10 – Day of Atonement). This is a time of fasting and deep repentance for our sins and iniquities (generational sins) and for the sins and iniquities of Singapore. It is a time for allowing Him to inscribe His Word on our hearts and to prepare us as a spotless bride for His soon coming.

During these forty days, we encourage all** to fast from food. You can fast food completely for all or some of the forty days or fast two meals and have only one meal a day. If you choose to have one meal we encourage you to have a Daniel Fast, eating one vegetarian meal a day. Alongside this food fast you should drink mainly water. On top of this you can also have a Media Fast where you refrain from using all social media, TV, internet and video games (except for essential work purposes) for the forty days.

We have prepared this “forty days” booklet for you to have a Prayer Altar time at least once a day as you are fasting.

On the last day, “The Day of Atonement”, we believe the Lord for a deep cleansing of our lives and land.

“For on that day the priest shall make atonement for you, to cleanse you, that you may be clean from all your sins before the Lord.” Leviticus 16:30

** Unless you have medical reasons you cannot fast. Check with your doctor if you are unsure.

INTRODUCTION

to the forty days of prayer

Each of the daily prayers are divided into **5 sections**. In **Section 1**, we proclaim God's Word and read 10 chapters of the Bible. In **Section 2**, we hallow the name of God, and praise Him based on what we have just read. Please worship Him with a song. **Section 3** is about personal repentance and bloodline cleansing. We repent for ourselves and our ancestors, in order that God can forgive us, cleanse us of iniquities and remove the legal rights that the enemy has against us. In **Section 4**, we intercede for Singapore. In **Section 5**, we declare the unification of the body of Christ and pray God's benediction over ourselves.

The daily prayers are based on the Prayer Altars framework, that each of us is a priest for our families, church, marketplace and nation. As we worship God, stand in identification repentance and intercede, we attract God's presence and He cleanses, delivers, heals and restores.

Days 1 - 5 focus on our role as priests and the various obstacles to priesthood. We then intercede for the nation based on the area of focus of the day.

Days 6 - 15 are dedicated to cleansing from generational iniquities, for ourselves and our bloodlines, as well as for the nation.

Days 16 - 17 are devoted to the healing of the soul, as many of us are wounded in some way or other, either in our own experience or because of our ancestors. We then pray for healing of the soul of the nation.

Days 18 - 37 focus on interceding for the seven mountains in Singapore, namely: religion (4 days); government (3 days); family (3 days); education (3 days); business (3 days); media (2 days) and arts and entertainment (2 days)¹.

Days 38 - 40 are prayers for Israel, the apple of God's eye. These are included as we need to pray for God's chosen people and their land, especially during this 70th year of independence.

Please use these prayers as a spring board to praying your own prayers as the Holy Spirit leads, especially when it comes to personal repentance.

May the Lord use these prayers to deepen and widen our intercession as priests of the land. May the Lord arise and transform Singapore for His glory!

1. We proclaim God's Word and read 10 chapters of the Bible

2. We hallow the name of God, and praise Him based on what we have just read. Please worship Him with a song

3. Personal Prayer

It is about personal repentance and bloodline cleansing. We repent for ourselves and our ancestors, in order that God can forgive us, cleanse us of iniquities and remove the legal rights that the enemy has against us.

3.1 Thanksgiving for being a child of God

John 1:12

But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, to those who believe in His name

Father God, I thank You that I am Your child, because of the atonement of Jesus Christ on the cross. He paid the price for my sins. Now I can freely call You, Abba Father, and come boldly to Your throne of grace at any time, to find mercy and grace in time of need.

3.2 Thanksgiving for being a priest

1 Peter 2:9

3. Personal Prayer

3.1 Repent for not being a priest

1 Peter 2:9

But you are a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light

Lord, while I thank You for my role as a priest to my family, workplace and nation, I confess that I often do not take up this role. I seldom stand in identificational repentance for them. I seldom bless them. In fact, I often speak negatively of my family members. I criticize colleagues and policies in my workplace. I complain about living in Singapore and criticize the government. Instead of blessing I curse. Forgive me, Lord.

3.2 Pray for understanding about being a priest

Holy Spirit, You are my counsellor. Help me to understand what it means for me to be a priest in my family, workplace and nation. Show me what adjustments I have to make in my lifestyle in order to be an effective priest.

3.3 Pray for a godly desire to be a priest

Lord, I ask for the godly desire to be a priest, to stand before You on behalf of my family, workplace and nation. I need You to put this fire in my heart, the passion to be a priest. I ask for this passion today. Let this zeal consume me!

3.4 Pray for obstacles to be revealed

Holy Spirit, please show me what the obstacles are to my being an effective priest in each area - my family; my workplace and my nation. There could be general obstacles, or specific ones for each of these different areas. Reveal to me my hidden sins. Show me the generational iniquities that hinder me. Shine Your light into my inner man and into my life, and show me, O Lord!

3.5 Rise up to be a priest

Lord, I declare that I will rise up to be an effective priest for my family, workplace, community and nation! I will rise up!

4. Intercession for Singapore

Psalm 2:8

Ask of Me, and I will give You the nations for Your inheritance, and the ends of the earth for Your possession.

DAY 2

12 AUGUST

ROLE AS PRIEST

4.1 Repent for not being a priest in the land

Lord, we repent that we have not regarded Singapore as our inheritance. We have neglected the land. We have not risen up to intercede for our nation. Instead, we have allowed darkness to encroach on our land – in our families, the marketplaces, government and communities. Sometimes we even contribute to this darkness ourselves, by sinning against You. We ask for Your forgiveness, O Lord.

4.2 Ask for Singapore as our inheritance

Today, we ask for Singapore as our inheritance. Thank You for giving us this land.

As sons and daughters of the soil, we declare that this land is our inheritance! We declare that this nation is our spiritual birthright.

We want to see her transformed for Your glory! We want to see transformation revival in all spheres of our nation - our families, workplaces, communities and government. We want to see Singapore fulfil her destiny!

5. Declaration and Benediction Prayer

I declare by faith that the body of Christ in Singapore will come together in unity to build prayer altars throughout this land. We will draw the presence of God and therefore, push back darkness in the land so that Singapore will experience transformational revival and fulfill her destiny.

May we receive His benediction by faith through the prayer below:

3. Personal Prayer

3.1 Requirement of being set apart

Leviticus 20:7

Consecrate yourselves therefore, and be holy, for I am the Lord your God.

Lord, You require Your people to be holy. We are to be a holy nation (1 Peter 2:9). We repent before You, Lord, for we have fallen short of Your standards of holiness.

3.2 Loving God with all of my heart

Deuteronomy 6:5

You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your strength.

Lord, I confess before You that I do not love You with all of my heart, soul and strength. My heart is divided. My soul is defiled. My strength is not used wholly to build Your Kingdom.

3.3 Love of the world

1 John 2:15-16

Do not love the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. For all that is in the world—the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life—is not of the Father but is of the world.

I love You, and yet I also love the world. I confess that I lust after success in my studies and in my career. I work very hard to achieve recognition and promotion in my job, and so have very little time and energy left to be a priest at my prayer altar. I give you the dregs of my energy, not my best and freshest time. I do not love You with all of my strength. I strive to please my boss in order to get my bonus and promotion, yet I do not strive to please You, my God. I repent of this sin. Please forgive me.

I confess my sexual lust. My eyes look lustfully at the opposite gender, I have looked at pornography, I have committed sexual immorality. I have sinned against You. I repent of these sins. Please forgive me.

I confess my pride, my independence, and of wanting to have my own way instead of yielding to Your will. When You prompt me, Holy Spirit, I brush aside Your prompting because of my stubbornness. I repent of these sins. Please forgive me.

3.4 Cleansing by the blood of Jesus

1 John 1:9

If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

Lord, I receive Your forgiveness. Thank You for forgiving me. I ask for Your blood to cleanse me, spirit, soul and body. Thank You for cleansing me.

4. Intercession for Singapore

4.1 Identification repentance on behalf of the Church in Singapore

Lord, just as we have repented of our own sins, we now stand in the gap on behalf of the Church in Singapore and confess before You the same sins.

- We fall short of Your requirement of holiness.
- We do not love You with all of our hearts, souls and strength.
- We love the world and the things in the world.
- We have lust of the eyes, flesh and the pride of life.

Forgive us, O God, and cleanse us!

4.2 Spirit of repentance

Send a spirit of repentance upon Your people who are called by Your name here in Singapore, that we may confess our sins and turn from our wicked ways! O Lord, hear our prayer! Hear us from Your holy hill and answer us speedily!

Help us to be effective priests, that we may intercede for our land!

5. Declaration and Benediction Prayer

I declare by faith that the body of Christ in Singapore will come together in unity to build prayer altars throughout this land. We will draw the presence of God and therefore, push back darkness in the land so that Singapore will experience transformational revival and fulfill her destiny.

May we receive His benediction by faith through the prayer below:

DAY 4

3. Personal Prayer

1 Peter 1:15-16

but as He who called you is holy, you also be holy in all your conduct, because it is written, "Be holy, for I am holy."

Lord, I continue to repent for falling short of Your standards of holiness.

3.1 Love of mammon

Matthew 6:24

No one can serve two masters; for either he will hate the one and love the other, or else he will be loyal to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and mammon.

Lord, I acknowledge that I love riches and what money can buy. I am constantly thinking of how much money I have, how much money I need. I think of how I can get more money to buy the things I want. I confess that I lust after material things and envy others who own them (*confess what these specific things are, either individually or in a group*). I am therefore distracted from focusing on things of Your Kingdom, on spiritual things. I repent of this sin. Please forgive me. I renounce and condemn the love of mammon.

3.2 Cleansing from the love of mammon

In Jesus' name, I ask for Your blood to flush out the love of mammon from my life.

3.3 Declaration of serving God

I declare that **I will not** serve mammon. I **will** serve the Lord Jesus Christ! I **will** love the Lord my God with all of my heart, with all of my soul, with all of my mind and with all of my strength (Mark 12:30)!

4. Intercession for Singapore

1 Timothy 6:10

For the love of money is a root of all kinds of evil, for which some have strayed from the faith in their greediness, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows.

4.1 Forgiveness for greed in our nation

Singapore was founded to be a trading port. Immigrants and businessmen came to Singapore to make money, Some did this in an unrighteous manner. As a result of greed, there was exploitation, corruption, oppression and even bloodshed. Your Word tells us that the love of money is a root of all kinds of evil. Forgive us, Lord for greed and the love of money in our forefathers.

DAY 4

14 AUGUST

OBSTACLES TO PRIESTHOOD (2)

4.2 Forgiveness for greed since independence

Forgive us, O Lord, for greed which some have exhibited in the pursuit of economic growth after independence. We ask for forgiveness for decisions which were formulated because of the love of mammon. We confess that profit has been the overriding priority for some businesses.

Some people have been valued for their economic contribution and not for who they are, men and women made in the image of God. Some of us have exploited our employees. Some of us have oppressed our foreign workers. Some of us have pressured our children to perform. Some of us have neglected the poor and disadvantaged in our midst. Some of us have looked down on the elderly and the handicapped, and those who have faced limitations in their ability to contribute economically.

(There maybe specifics which you may be aware of, or the Holy Spirit prompts you to repent of. Please repent of these.)

Forgive us, O Lord. We repent and renounce the love of mammon in some of us in Singapore.

4.3 Declaration of serving God instead of mammon

We declare that there is only one master over Singapore – the Lord Jesus Christ! We declare that we will not be slaves of mammon. Singapore will serve the Lord Jesus Christ!

4.4 Declaration of the blessings of obedience

Deuteronomy 28:2

And all these blessings shall come upon you and overtake you, because you obey the voice of the Lord your God

Deuteronomy 28:8

The Lord will command the blessing on you in your storehouses and in all to which you set your hand, and He will bless you in the land which the Lord your God is giving you.

We declare that Singapore will obey the Lord! And the blessings of obedience will come upon us and overtake us. We will prosper because of the blessings of the Lord! We will be successful in all to which we set our hands! The Lord will bless us in Singapore!

5. Declaration and Benediction Prayer

I declare by faith that the body of Christ in Singapore will come together in unity to build prayer altars throughout this land. We will draw the presence of God and therefore, push back darkness in the land so that Singapore will experience transformational revival and fulfill her destiny.

Lord, I continue to repent for falling short of Your standards of holiness.

3.1 Repentance for fear of man

Proverbs 29:25

The fear of man brings a snare, but whoever trusts in the Lord shall be safe

Lord, I repent that I have feared man more than fearing You. I have been afraid to say, "No" to my bosses who ask me to participate in ungodly activities, for fear of offending them. I have been fearful of being laughed at, and of being excluded by others in an effort not to defile myself. I have compromised. *(You may wish to confess of personal sins in this regard as prompted by the Holy Spirit, either individually or as a group).* Please forgive me, Lord.

3.2 Repentance for fear of evil

Lord Jesus, I confess that I am afraid of the devil, of the evil and harm that he can do to me and my family. As a result, I am hesitant to stand in the gap and engage in spiritual warfare as a priest.

This shows my lack of faith in You. You have already conquered Satan by Your death on the cross. Your blood is able to cleanse me and protect me. Hallelujah! I declare that He who is in me is greater than he who is in the world (1 John 4:4).

3.3 Put on the full armour of God

Ephesians 6:13

Therefore take up the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand.

I will put on the full armour of God for the battle is not against flesh and blood, but against the kingdom of darkness. I will be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might. Through God we will do valiantly, for it is He who shall tread down our enemies (Psalm 108:13). No weapon formed against me shall prosper! (Isaiah 54:17a).

4. Intercession for Singapore

4.1 Repent of fear of survival

Isaiah 31:1

Woe to those who go down to Egypt for help, and rely on horses, who trust in chariots because they are many, and in horsemen because they are very strong, But who do not look to the Holy One of Israel, nor seek the Lord!

DAY 5

15 AUGUST

OBSTACLES TO PRIESTHOOD (3)

Father God, forgive us that, as a small island without natural resources, some of us and our ancestors have been fearful that we cannot survive on our own. As a result, some of us have turned to other gods. Some of us have trusted in our own efforts and believed that we could be successful without You. We have not looked to You, the Holy One of Israel, nor have we sought You.

4.2 Repent of the fear of being rejected and abandoned

I renounce murder by all kinds of weapons; gang murders; killing of innocent people during times of wars; cruelty; violence and torture. I repent of bloodshed and ask for Your forgiveness, Lord.

3.2 Personal and Generational Repentance for Anger, Unforgiveness and Revenge

*Matthew 5:21-22
You have heard that it was said to those of old, 'You shall not murder, and whoever murders will be in danger of the judgment.' Ezekiel 16:20-21

Moreover you took your sons and your daughters, whom you bore to Me, and these you sacrificed to them to be devoured. Were your acts of harlotry a small matter, that you have slain My children and offered them up to them by causing them to pass through the fire?

Lord, the sacrifice of children by passing them through fire by the Israelites and the surrounding nations was an abomination to You. Abortion is the same. It is the shedding of innocent blood.

On behalf of my ancestors, I repent for the abortions which could have been performed in my family lines. I repent also for the babies who could have been abandoned or killed. Forgive us, O Lord. We repent that we have not valued life, that we have succumbed to economic, social and other pressures in aborting the unborn or abandoning and killing new-born babies.

4. Intercession for Singapore

4.1 Repentance for Abortion

Lord, on behalf of the nation, we repent for abortion. Thousands of fetuses are killed every year. Much innocent blood has been shed and the land has been defiled. We ask for forgiveness.

We empathise with the struggles of those who made the decision to abort. Lord, we repent on behalf of those who were married and decided to abort because having a child would interfere with career progression or would be a financial burden. We repent on behalf of those who aborted in the 1970s and 1980s when "Stop at Two" was the government policy and it was economically and socially inconvenient to have more than two children. We also repent on behalf of unwed mothers, especially teenagers. Forgive us for fornication.

We ask for forgiveness for the doctors and nurses who have carried out these abortions. We ask for forgiveness for the ease of having abortions in Singapore.

We thank You, Lord, for the downward trend, that this form of bloodshed has decreased from a peak of nearly 24,000 in 1985 to about 12,000 in 2007 to about 7,200 in 2016. The number of abortions performed on women under the age of 20 also fell from about 1,300 in 2007 to 343 in 2016. We ask that You bring down the number of abortions even further.

4.2 Spirit of repentance and Fear of the Lord

Lord, we ask for a spirit of repentance to come upon the nation for abortion. Only the fear of the Lord, and His mercy and forgiveness, are the permanent solutions to abortion. Let Singapore fear You, Lord, that we may not sin against You!

3. Personal Prayer

3.1 Personal and Generational Repentance for Bitterness

Acts 8:22-23

Repent therefore of this your wickedness, and pray God if perhaps the thought of your heart may be forgiven you. For I see that you are poisoned by bitterness and bound by iniquity.

Hebrews 12:14-15

Pursue peace with all people, and holiness, without which no one will see the Lord: looking carefully lest anyone fall short of the grace of God; lest any root of bitterness springing up cause trouble, and by this many become defiled

The Greek word “pikria” means acidity (especially poison), deeply or violently bitter, often referring to relationships. Father God, I and my ancestors repent of the root of bitterness. We repent for unforgiveness in relationships, resulting in relationship friction all the way to violence, cruelty and even murder. We have been poisoned by bitterness, which has passed down the generations.

I and my ancestors have had loved ones who were victims of murder, violence and cruelty. We ourselves have been hurt. We have been deeply wounded and as a result, have harboured unforgiveness in our hearts. We have chosen the path of hurting the oppressors instead of forgiving them. We have cursed them and sought all manner of revenge.

We repent for bitter root judgements and of being critical and judgmental of others. We repent of easily taking offence. We release our anger and bitterness to You. Forgive us, Lord. *(Please forgive by name those who have hurt you or your ancestors, if you have not done so already.)*

Cleanse me, O Lord, from the root of bitterness. Cleanse me from anger. Cleanse me from easily taking offence.

Thank You, Lord, for Your forgiveness! I am cleansed by the blood of the Lamb!

4. Intercession for Singapore

4.1 Repentance on behalf of Singapore for Generational Bitterness

Lord, many of our ancestors came to Singapore to work as coolies (Chinese) and indentured labour (Indians), in the rubber plantations, tin mines, as servants of the wealthy, and on the wharves. Some of our ancestors have been involved in secret societies and engaged in idolatry, unholy blood covenants and other defiling practices. For them, unforgiveness and revenge has been the order of the day. We repent on behalf of our ancestors. Forgive us, Lord.

Throughout history in many Asian civilisations, women have been regarded as the inferior gender and have been exploited and oppressed. There have been rape, abuse and much rejection. Polygamy, and the binding of feet has caused much pain and humiliation. As a result, there has been much bitterness. Children have received the bitterness of their mothers, and this bitterness has been perpetrated from generation to generation. We repent on behalf of our ancestors. Forgive us, Lord. We now want to bless those of our mothers and grandmothers who are alive. Thank You for their love and nurture of us. May they come to know You, may they experience the shalom of the Lord!

Many of our families have suffered the loss of a loved one during the Japanese Occupation. There is bitterness in our hearts because of this woundedness. On behalf of ourselves and our ancestors, we forgive the Japanese who have killed some of our ancestors. We bless Japan and ask Lord, for Your mercy to be on this country that they may come to know You.

Bitterness was experienced by some when Singapore separated from Malaysia. Since then, there has been some rivalry and jealousy between the two nations. As Singaporeans and on behalf of our ancestors, we forgive some Malaysians for any rejection of our ancestors. Forgive some of us for harbouring resentment against Malaysia. Instead, we ask that You bless Malaysia. May Your people in Singapore and Malaysia be united in Christ, for the glory of Your Kingdom!

I declare by faith that the body of Christ in Singapore will come together in unity to build prayer altars throughout this land. We will draw the presence of God and therefore, push back darkness in the land so that Singapore will experience transformational revival and fulfill her destiny.

Help us, Lord, to do good to those in other countries and those in need. May we be generous in our giving at every level – government, social, business and personal. In particular, may we give to those in Your Kingdom in other countries who are in need.

We ask that You help us to conduct ourselves with gentleness and generosity as we travel and do business around the world, especially in developing countries. It is You who exalts us, and not we ourselves.

Many of us measure success by what we achieve: good grades, good housing, cars, good family (*happy marriage, healthy, smart children who are performing well in schools*). I strive and strive in the flesh instead of relying on You. I forget that our success is due to the abilities and blessings that You gave me. Forgive me, Lord.

Father God, I confess that I bring this worldly performance orientation into my spiritual life. Deep down inside, I believe that I need to earn Your love by good deeds, and that You are a demanding and distant God who punishes me if I do not “perform”. Forgive me, Lord, for believing in this lie. I ask that You replace this lie with Your truth. Your truth is that I am Your child, that You love me with an everlasting love, and I am saved by grace through faith and not by works.

At the root of performance orientation is fear – fear that I am not valued, fear that I am not good enough, and fear that no one will take care of me. Lord, I confess and repent of these fears. (*Take some time to allow the Holy Spirit to bring back memories of fears that need healing, and confess them.*)

Some of these fears are hereditary, because many of my forefathers suffered from poverty and hunger, and had to fight for survival for themselves and their families. I ask for forgiveness on their behalf for allowing these fears to control our lives. I ask for the blood of Jesus to cleanse my bloodlines from these fears. We receive Your forgiveness and cleansing, Father God.

I repent of believing in the lies that led to these fears – lies which reside deep down in my heart that I am unloved, unworthy and uncared for. I tear down these lies, and replace them with the truth that Jesus our good Shepherd loves me and takes care of me, my family loves me, and brothers and sisters in the church loves me. (*Take some time to allow the love of God to soak our inner man.*)

3.2 Seeking first the Kingdom of God and achieving our destiny

Instead of performance orientation to achieve worldly success, I ask that You, Father God, help me shift my mindset toward seeking first Your Kingdom and Your righteousness. Help me to be Kingdom-minded in my personal life, my family, my work in the marketplace and my service in church.

Help me to know what is written in my Book in heaven, so that I can focus my mind and energy on fulfilling my destiny.

Fill us to overflowing with Your love, Lord. When we are filled with Your love we will be content, like a weaned child resting in the arms of the mother. We need not compare because we are filled with love.

3.3 Repentance for imparting competitiveness to our children

We confess that, as parents, consciously or unconsciously, we have imparted to our children a spirit of competitiveness. We compare each child's performance with another's; we compare our children's achievements with their classmates and children of other parents. Directly or indirectly, our attitude and actions convey that we love them only if they perform. Forgive us, Lord. We repent of imparting to our children performance orientation and competitiveness.

Help us instead to have and impart unconditional love to our children.

Israel: the revelation center. From this land, the land of Moses, the prophets and the apostles, came the Word of God.

Israel: the spiritual center. In Bethlehem Jesus was born. In Nazareth He grew to maturity. In Galilee He walked and taught on the mountainsides and beside the Sea. In Jerusalem our Lord was crucified, buried and rose from the dead. From the Mount of Olives He ascended. And to the Mount of Olives He will return; His feet will first touch down upon the Mount of Olives (Zechariah 14:4).

Israel: the prophecy center. Prophecy is “pre-written history.” The land of Israel is the only land belonging to God’s people. The details of their future are minutely recorded in the Bible. If you want to know what God is doing, study Israel and her people.

4.1. Pray for the Jewish people to know Christ as Messiah

Consider the words of Jewish Christian Avi Snyder:

“Faith in Yeshua is not a threat to our Jewish existence. Rather, faith in Yeshua is an affirmation of our identity as Jews. The God who saved us through our faith in Jesus is the very God who deepens our Jewish identity through that very same faith. More often than not, Jewish people who believe in Yeshua experience a heightened commitment to their Jewish heritage and roots.
